## Letter to Parents for School Meal Programs Special Provision Options (Provision 2 Non-Base Year & Community Eligibility Provision)

Dear Parent or Guardian:

We are pleased to inform you that Cairo-Durham Central School District will be implementing a meal certification option available to schools participating in the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs for 2018-2019 school year.

### What does this mean for your child(ren) attending the school(s) identified above?

All students enrolled at Cairo-Durham Central Schools are eligible to receive a healthy breakfast and lunch at school at **no charge** to your household each day of the 2018-2019 school year. No further action is required of you. Your child(ren) will be able to participate in these meal programs without having to pay a fee or submit an application.

**No application is necessary, however a Household Income Eligibility Form is requested (to be used for reporting purposes and to determine if the district and/or your child(ren) may be eligible to receive additional funding as part of federal programs). For your convenience, the Household Income Eligibility Form has been enclosed with this mailing.**
