Safety is Still the #1 Priority

- Social distancing will still be maintained in all classrooms and the cafeteria
- Masks will still be required at all times (except lunch and planned mask breaks)
- Daily Health Screeners and Temperature Checks
- Materials will still be disseminated digitally
- The only thing changing is the number of days students are in the building; all other practices remain as presented at the beginning of the year

Our Current Model

- Two teams: Blue & Red
- Blue kids attend Mondays and Thursdays
- Red kids attend Tuesdays and Fridays
- Every student learns remotely on Wednesdays
- Every hybrid student attends in person 6 times over a three week period

New Model

- Three teams: A, B, & C
- Two teams attend in a given week; one team is remote that week
- Week 1: Teams A & B (in-person); Team C (remote)
- Week 2: Teams B & C (in-person); Team A (remote)
- Week 3: Teams C & A (in-person); Team B (remote)
- No fully remote day
- Every hybrid student attends 10 times in a three-week period

Comparison

Type of Day	Current Hybrid Model	New Hybrid Model
In-person days	6 days (non-consecutive)	10 days (consecutive)
Remote days (all students)	3 days (non-consecutive)	0 days
Remote days (total)	9 days (non-consecutive)	5 days (consecutive)

The above figures are based on a three-week period.

NOTE: All safety measures established at the beginning of the year remain the same. Social distancing is still in place and masks are still required to be worn at all times (except during pre-planned mask breaks and lunch).

Timeline

November 13 - All students and families informed of team (A, B, or C)

November 20 - CDMS/CDHS will email calendar that includes which teams are present each week

November 30 - Hybrid model change goes into effect; students who opted to switch from remote to hybrid for Q2 will begin hybrid learning

Reminder: You may choose “fully remote” at any time; notify CDMS office






Introduction to Google Classroom for Remote Learning

1. Q - What about snow days? A - As of now Snow Days will be handled just like in the past, no planned instruction.
2. Q - Will bussing be impacted? A - Transportation will analyze the route and make any needed adjustments. They would communicate directly to families if pick-up and drop-off times were to change.
3. Q - Would there be another change at the next marking period? A - Unless things change dramatically this model is sustainable through the remainder of the year. Students will continue in A,B,C groups indefinitely. Parents can request for their child to be Fully Remote at any time.
4. Q - If my student attends every day now will that change? A - All students who attend every day currently will continue.
5. Q - If my student misses the bus or can't make it for some reason can they attend classes online? A - Yes, attendance in any fashion is better than not attending, however these occurrences should be the exception and not the rule.
