March 20 is World Oral Health Day!!

The CDC recommends that children and adults brush their teeth twice a day with a toothpaste containing fluoride. They also recommend drinking tap water with fluoride in it. Flossing daily is encouraged. The American Dental Association suggests eating a healthy diet that limits snacks and beverages containing sugar. The ADA states that dental cleanings should be done at least once a year to help prevent and treat oral diseases. Sealants are recommended for children and adolescents to help with the prevention of dental caries (cavities). Happy March!!
